only gift he had left, the Bwindi Impenetrable Forest. In 1992 that forest was taken away from the Batwa making them conservation refugees. Forced to live in a world where their hunter-gatherer lifestyle, their knowledge, and their language were useless, the Batwa were dying at an alarming rate. Dr. Scott Kellerman will share how God's living word addresses the needs of mind, body, and soul and is saving some of the most impoverished people on the planet.

THE CHALLENGE OF ISLAM

Archbp. Edmund Akanya is Bishop of Kebbi in N.W. Nigeria, in a 70% Muslim, sharia-compliant state. In the face of persecution, the gospel is being preached and churches are being planted as Christians are challenged to pray, reach out, build bridges of friendship and live Christ-like lives that incarnate the gospel.

BIBLE STUDY, TESTIMONY, WORSHIP

The Rev. Miguel Uchoa, rector of Holy Spirit Anglican Church near Recife, Brazil, will lead us in daily Bible studies. Holy Spirit is reaching its community and has grown from 25 in 1996 to 1,400—65% of whom came to faith in the last 9 years.

Baroness Caroline Cox, a member of the British House of Lords and founder of HART, The Humanitarian Aid Relief Trust providing advocacy for the persecuted, will speak on the challenge of resurgent Islam, including in North America.

Dr. Bill Taylor, former director of the Mission Commission of the World Evangelical Alliance, is preaching on commitment, and the Rev. Qampicha Daniel Wario of northern Kenya, is celebrating eucharist using a Kenyan liturgy

PARTNERING FOR THE UNREACHED

The Rev. S.D. Ponraj of Bihar Out-Reach Network (BORN) will share how the gospel has been spreading among youth, castes, and tribal groups as churches work together to reach the unreached and plant 10,000 churches in Bihar, a northern state in India.

Testimonies from missionaries will remind us that Jesus is the pearl worth any price. Worship will be led by Jonathan and Sarah Blamire (formerly of Well-spring) and the Prince George Winyah, SC, worship group, using traditional and contemporary music to help us encounter the living God through worship.

BROTHERS & SISTERS IN MYANMAR

There are 70,000 Anglican Christians in Myanmar (formerly Burma). The Most Rev. Stephen Than, Archbishop of the Province of Myanmar, will share on the work of the church in Myanmar.
